## What does NDHA do?

- On behalf of the City, stewards the maintenance of "green spaces"
- Excludes social and community-focused activities as well as Griffith Woods



# Highlights

- Transition from United
- Supplier evaluation
  - Assesses many facets of qualification
  - 3 out of 12 deemed potential candidates
- Contract bid process
- Records of account, billing and collections
- Re-assessment of directcontrolled property and elimination of property taxes



## Finance Committee

## - Challenges

- Created database of all 1,636 residences
- Reconciled database to A/R list provided by United
- Mailed statements & invoices to occupied properties as of 2006
  - 1,405 members
- Setup NDHA phone, Visa payment options, transferred bank account, hired bookkeeper and auditor
- Collected all outstanding accounts
