Finance Committee Looking Forward

- Finalize and approve a Capital Plan
- Bill remaining residences
- Continued implementation of the NDHA's Collection Policy
- Pursue the collection of remaining homeowner accounts in arrears
- Start the 2012 Budget



Collection Policy

- Background
- NDHA STEPS:
 - Mailing of annual invoice (January/February)
 - Newsletter article (April/May)
 - Boulevard sign (June)
 - Fees due June 29th
 - In July, all overdue accounts receive a friendly reminder letter along with a copy of current year invoice marked 'PAST DUE'
 - If no response received, turn over unpaid fees to NDHA lawyer



Collection Policy con't

NDHA LAWYER STEPS:

- issuance of a Demand Letter
- redemption period provided
- issuance of final Demand Letter
- filing of Statement of Claim
- Order Nisi (Order for Sale)
- home is "Listed for Sale"



Status of Collections

As at May 30, 2011

- 1,634 residences have been invoiced for the 2011 Association fee of which 43% have already forwarded payment in advance of the June 29 due date
- 69 accounts remain in arrears for the 2010 fee &/or prior (<5%) \$22,079.25

LANDSCAPING UPDATE

Landscape Committee Report - Highlights

- Over 4,000 work hours of landscape contract related work
 - Soccer fields
 - Grass cutting
 - Public areas tree maintenance
 - Flower beds
 - Waterfall maintenance
 - Garbage pick-up of public cans
 - Snow clearing of pathways
 - Weed spraying
 - Irrigation maintenance & monitoring



Landscape Committee Report - Challenges

- Weed spraying over the years has given us some control over thistle and dandelion growth.
- We are working with City's Urban Forestry division to replace dead and diseased trees. This year we are looking at approximately 45.
- Discovery Ridge Blvd. down the hill from the waterfall. This carried on the theme of the entrance median. It was done in the NDHA philosophy of a more natural look with greater drought tolerance and requiring less labour to maintain.



Landscape Committee Report – Current Activities & Future Focus

- This June we will continue the resodding of the medians along Discovery Ridge Blvd. up to the mall and Discovery Ridge Hill.
- Working with Urban Forestry we will be replacing the dead trees.
- Working with the City to clean up graffiti as it occurs.
- Working on a plan to revitalize the green space at the end of Phase 10
- Working with contractor to clean up and maintain the utility corridor in Phase 1.



Landscape Committee Report – Current Activities & Future Focus

- After competitive bid process, new landscape maintenance contract signed.
- Area supervisor hired to liaise with ULS.
- Report has been conducted on public fences (wrought iron, brick, and stucco) throughout the community.
 We need to decide how to proceed with this.
- Benches will be evaluated and refinished as required.
- Looking to possibly add park benches and/or garbage cans, as necessary.



Orders of Business

- Appointment of Auditors
- Special Resolution
 - Requires approval by 75% of all members in good standing and in attendance in person or by proxy
- Capital Plan survey
- Capital Plan discussion



Appointment of Auditor

To appoint Thompson Penner & Lo as auditors of the NDHA for the ensuing year at such remuneration as may be approved by the Directors of the NDHA.



Special Resolution

- Accept Discovery Vista Point residents as members of the NDHA provided as many properties on that street as possible are encumbered.
- The NDHA accepts the residents of Discovery Vista Point to become members of the NDHA.
- The NDHA agrees to assume responsibility for maintenance of public green spaces adjacent to the properties on Discovery Vista Point.



Special Resolution - Background

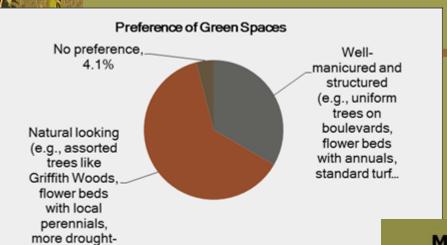
- The Board has identified some properties without the NDHA encumbrance.
- Only residents with the encumbrance on title can be members.
- Issue is whether NDHA should assume maintenance responsibilities.



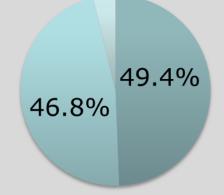

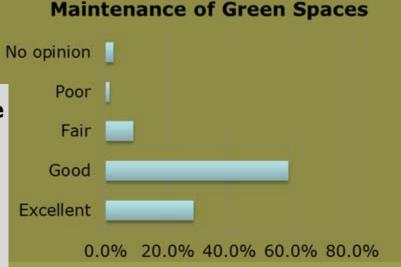


3.8% Level of Cost vs. Maintenance



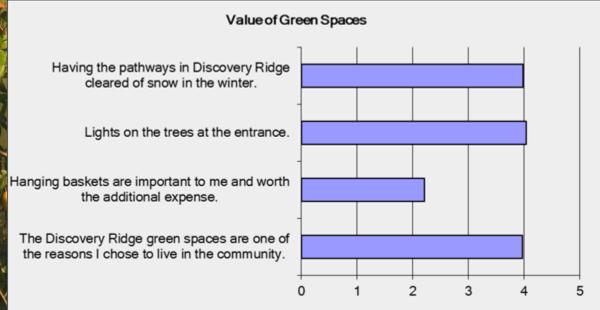

Value of Green Spaces

What do you like best about the maintenance of the community: -look of the boulevards; nice mix of manicured and natural -Waterfall area -Overall maintenance of green spaces: grass mowing -Christmas lights -Efforts of the landscaping committee



What could be most improved? – common themes

- Replace dead trees (29%)
- Use native plants (18%)
- Provide same focus to areas off Discovery Ridge Boulevard
- Improve weed control and dandelion control
- Repair/replace sod
- Fix irrigation
- More color



Use of NDHA Funds



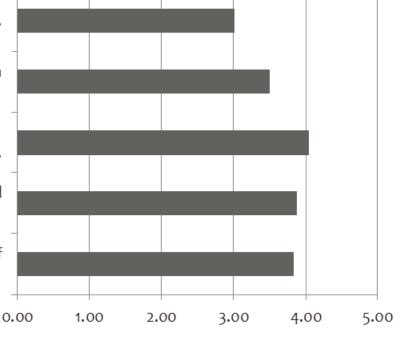
Assist the City with community improvements.

Set aside money for emergencies and unanticipated events.

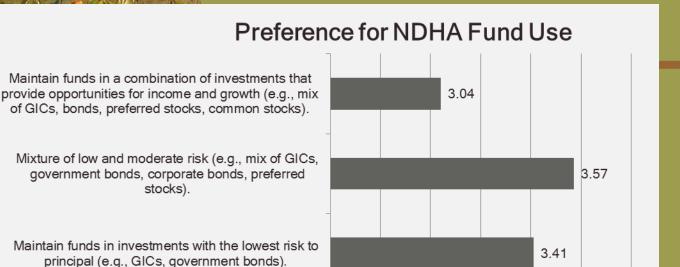
Maintain low fees in the future through investment of capital.

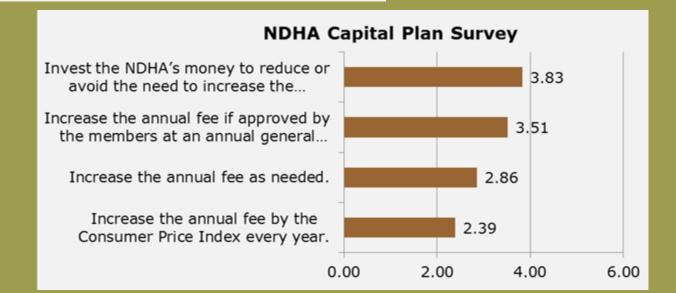

Capital Plan

- Review of future capital requirements
 - Forecast of short-term landscape maintenance and rehabilitation needs
 - Projected 25-year operational budget
 - Consideration of unanticipated expenses
 - Survey of NDHA members



Capital Plan

- Objectives
 - Well-maintained, sustainable, and natural-looking green spaces that are attractive and enjoyable.
 - Excellence in maintenance of green spaces.
 - Balance of maintenance and rehabilitation needs with revenue.
 - Investment strategy that allocates funds to two categories:
 - lowest risk to principal (e.g., term deposits, guaranteed investment certificates, government bonds)
 - mixture of low and moderate risk investments (e.g., term deposits, guaranteed investment certificates, government bonds, corporate bonds, preferred stocks)



Capital Plan

- General Reserve Fund
 - Protect long-term viability of NDHA and its services
- Green Space Enhancement Reserve Fund
 - Modify and rehabilitate green spaces
- Operational Support Fund
 - Supplement the operating budget
